2011 BMA GREGORY CRINUM PLANT SHUTDOWN

Allfab provided a team of 120 personnel to supply project management, supervision, WHS and trades to complete the 2011 major outage at the Gregory Crinum CHPP Plant. Work completed during the 5 week shut down included:

- 300T surge bins refurbishment
- Modules 1 to 9 various work including structural steel replacement
- Valves and piping, warn chutes and wear plates, pulley and drum replacements
- Thickener cyclones
- Load out train chutes & structural remediation
- Replacement of pump bases
- Water tank replacement,
- Structural remediation of ploughs
- Conveyor maintenance including idlers and troughs as well as structural remediation
- Hand railing replacement and repairs
- Fabrication and replacement of weir boxes

DRAGLINE REPAIRS FOR RCR RESOURCES

At the completion of the shutdown for UGL Allfab was engaged by RCR to provide experienced supervision and mechanical labour to complete the Dragline Maintenance Outage.

1000 TONNE SURGE BIN FOR AMS

During the shutdown Allfab assisted the head contractor by providing personnel to change the internal wear liners in the surge bin. Our team worked around the clock for 15 days enabling the contractor to meet completion deadlines.

DEMOLITION OF REDUNDANT PLANT

Allfab undertook the project to remove the existing denver float cells, warman pumps and associated pipework, including motors. The controlled removal and make safe was completed by our team on a 2 week fly in/fly out basis.
